Main case

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from the court of District Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib to the court of District Judge, Chandigarh, Mohali or Panchkula.

Counsel for the respondent has no objection to the transfer of the petition but has also stated that jurisdiction to file petition under Section 13 of the Act for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce lies at Sri

Muktsar Sahib, whereas the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition on several grounds from Sri Muktsar Sahib to Chandigarh, Mohali or Panchkula.

Since the respondent-husband has no objection, on consensus the instant petition is transferred to Chandigarh.

The petition stands disposed of.
