As per the report of Registry, notice issued to the respondent has been received back duly served but none has put in appearance on his behalf. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

The wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition filed by the husband, respondent herein, under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter mentioned as the Act) from Zira, District Ferozepur to Moga on the plea that she is residing at village Buttar Kalan, District Moga and it is very difficult for her to attend to the petition at Zira. It is claimed that the petition under Section 9 of the Act has been filed by the respondent-husband merely to harass her though he had earlier filed a petition for divorce at Moga. It is also stated that another petition under Section 125 Cr.PC had been preferred by the wife at Moga.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Civil Judge (Senior Division), Zira, District Ferozepur is transferred to the court of competent jurisdiction at Moga. Compliance be made by all concerned.

Disposed of accordingly.
