Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

The respondent has been served through father. This is a sufficient service. There is no representation on behalf of the respondent. Proceeded against ex-parte.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Amloh to Malerkotla, alleging that she feels insecure at Amloh which is at a distance of 70 kilometers from Malerkotla. It is averred that the respondent-husband is already proceeded against ex-parte in proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Amloh and this petition under Section 9 of the Act has been preferred by him at Amloh merely to harass, humiliate and dwarf her in her stature.

In view of the circumstances explained in the petition, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is ordered to be transferred from Amloh to the court of competent jurisdiction at Malerkotla. Compliance be made by all concerned.

The petition stands disposed of.
