Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Sections 6 and 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent for custody of the minor child, from Ludhiana to Ropar.

It is also urged that the petitioner is the widow of brother of the respondent, who has filed the aforesaid petition for custody of the minor child born out of her wedlock with her earlier husband and now resides with her second husband at Morinda, which is at a distance of 70 kilometers from Ludhiana and, therefore, keeping in view the totality of circumstances, it will be very difficult for her to travel 70 kilometers from Morinda to Ludhiana on each and every date of hearing, along with her two minor children, one of whom has born out of her remarriage.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Sections 6, 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 pending at Ludhiana is transferred to Ropar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
