As per the report of Registry, notice issued to the respondent has been received back duly served but none has put in appearance on his behalf. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, at Phul, District Bathinda as the petitioner-wife is residing with her father at Moga alongwith one minor child of four months.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Phul, District Bathinda is transferred to District Judge, Moga, who would further transfer the same to the competent court of jurisdiction at Nihal Singh Wala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
