In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the

husband, respondent herein, from Kurukshetra to Panipat as the petitioner is residing with her brother, mother and one minor child at Panipat which is approximately 100 Kms. away from Kurukshetra.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Panipat. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Panipat and has also got registered a case bearing FIR No.526 dated 08.07.2013, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat.

3. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

4. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Kurukshetra is transferred to District Judge, Panipat. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
