Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Amritsar to Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as also under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Malerkotla. Besides this, it is very difficult for the petitioner to travel approximately 200 kilometers from Malerkotla to Amritsar all alone on each and every date of hearing, specifically when she is living in penury having no source of income to incur the travelling expenses.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Amritsar is transferred to Malerkotla. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
