As per the report of Registry, notice issued to the respondent has been received back duly served but none has put in appearance on his behalf. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Kurukshetra to Amritsar as the petitioner is residing with her widowed mother and minor child at village Daburji, District Amritsar which is more than 300 Kms. away from Kurukshetra.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Amritsar.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.
5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Kurukshetra is transferred to District Judge, Amritsar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
