As per the report of Registry, notice issued to the respondent has been received back duly served but none has put in appearance on his behalf. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Nabha, District Patiala to Gurdaspur as the petitioner is residing with her parents at village Marrar Patti, Kammo Nangal, Tehsil Batala, District Gurdaspur which is more than 200 Kms. away from Nabha, District Patiala.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Batala, District Gurdaspur.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Nabha, District Patiala is transferred to District Judge, Gurdaspur, who may further transfer the same to the court of competent jurisdiction at Batala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
