Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short “the Act”) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by way of decree of divorce from Bhiwani to Chandigarh.

It is urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Chandigarh. It is also urged that petitioner-wife is posted at General Post Office, Sector 17, Chandigarh and she has two minor child who are studying in class 4th and class 1st respectively at Chandigarh.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before District Judge (Family Court), Bhiwani is transferred to District Judge, Chandigarh, who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands allowed.
