There is an application under Section 151 CPC for permission to bring on record the details of the cases pending at Karnal between Rajwant Kaur-petitioner and her husband Jaskaran Singh-respondent. Copy given.

In view of the facts mentioned in the application, which are supported by an affidavit and when there is no dispute about those, the same is allowed.

Consequently, detail of the cases pending at Karnal between Rajwant Kaur-petitioner and her husband Jaskaran Singh-respondent, is taken on record.

TA No.399 of 2014

In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of Civil Suit No.231 dated 15.04.2014 titled “Gurdeep Singh and others Versus Rajwant Kaur and another” filed by Gurdeep Singh, who is father-in-law of petitioner-Rajwant Kaur, respondent No.1 herein, from Rajpura to Karnal as the petitioner is residing with her parents and two minor children at H.No.109, New Prem Colony, Kaithal Road, Karnal (Haryana) which is approximately 120 Kms. away from Rajpura.

It is also urged that the petitioner has got registered a case bearing FIR No.1226 dated 18.12.2013, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station, Karnal against the husband, which is pending adjudication in the court at Karnal. Besides this, she has also filed an execution application seeking execution of the exparte order of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Karnal dated 11.11.2014 passed in the proceedings under the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 which is also pending adjudication in the courts at Karnal.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, Civil Suit No.231 dated 15.04.2014 pending before Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rajpura is transferred to District Judge, Karnal who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
