NAVITA SINGH, J.

The applicant – wife seeks transfer of the petition filed by the respondent – husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, from Bathinda to Moga. It is submitted that the two cases, one under the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and the other under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, are pending at Moga. The distance between the two places is more than 105 kilometres and the applicant has a female child of 2½ years and it is very difficult for her to travel to Bathinda with the child and also suffer the expenses thereof.

Request for transfer is opposed by the counsel for the respondent.

In view of the plea taken by the applicant, which is supported by an affidavit, the request is allowed. The petition for divorce filed by the respondent stands transferred from Bathinda to Moga. The parties to appear

before District Judge, Moga, on 18.03.2015.

Letter be written to District Judge, Bathinda, to transfer the records of the case to District Court, Moga, in the meanwhile.
