There is no appearance on behalf of the respondent, despite service. As such, the respondent is proceeded against ex-parte.

1. The wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition filed under Section 13 (i) (a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, by the husband, respondent herein, from District Panipat to Jhajjar as the petitioner is presently residing at H.No.8/767, Gali No.7, Aggarwal Colony, Bahadurgarh, Distt. Jhajjar.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has got registered an FIR No.20 dated 06.02.2014 at Police Station Line par, Bahadurgarh, Distt. Jhajjar for the offence under Sections 498-A, 323 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC against the respondents and others and petitioner has also filed a petition under Section 125 of Cr.P.C, which are pending adjudication in the Court at Bahadurgarh at Jhajjar. It is very difficult for the petitioner to travel 100 Kms for attending each and every date of hearing.

3. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

4. Sequelly, the petition filed Section 13 (i) (a) of the Hindu

Marriage Act, 1955, pending before learned Additional District Judge, Panipat is transferred to District Judge, Jhajjar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply with.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
