Instant review application has been filed under Order 47 Rule 1 read with Sections 114/151 CPC for review of the judgment dated 21.09.2015 passed by this Court in CWP-23154-2012.

The applicant-petitioner filed CWP-23154-2012 which has been dismissed vide order dated 21.09.2015. The petitioner has sought review of the order dated 21.09.2015 on the ground that in pursuance of depositing process charges vide receipt dated 14.08.2012, Assistant Executive Engineer, Operation, Sub Division, Punjab State Power Corporation, Ltd., Anandpur Sahib (Ropar) has issued memo dated 15.07.2014 requiring the applicant to deposit a sum of Rs.36,802/- in order to get remove 11 KV Line passing through the proposed piece of land. The communication dated 15.07.2014 clearly establishes that it is

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practically feasible to remove the wire in question and the authorities concerned have agreed to shift the high tension line to some other place.

I have heard learned counsel for the applicant and perused the record.

The claim of petitioner has been rightly declined on the ground that it is the condition precedent that the land should be clear from high tension overhead line and if high tension overhead line passes over the plot, the same will be disqualified.

Learned counsel for the applicant has not been able to make out a case which may warrant review of the order dated 21.09.2015. The writ petition was dismissed on merit. Learned counsel for the applicant has failed to show any error apparent on record.

Instant review application is dismissed.
