Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Jalandhar to Hoshiarpur. It is averred that the respondent-husband is also facing another criminal complaint inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC as also proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Hoshiarpur but this petition under Section 13 of the Act has been preferred by him at Jalandhar merely to harass, humiliate and dwarf her in her stature.

No notice is being issued to the respondent in order to obviate delay, more so when no prejudice is likely to be caused to the respondent in view of the nature of order which this Court proposes to pass.

In view of the circumstances explained in the petition and particularly when the husband is already facing a criminal complaint as also proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Hoshiarpur, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is ordered to be transferred from Jalandhar to the court of competent jurisdiction at Hoshiarpur. Compliance be made by all concerned.

The petition stands disposed of.
