As per the report of Registry, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served through father which is sufficient service but there is no representation on behalf of the respondent. Therefore, he is proceeded against ex-parte.

2. In this petition counsel for the wife, the petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Panipat to Ambala as the petitioner is residing with her parents and one minor daughter at Ambala which is approximately 120 Kms. away from Panipat.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication in the court at Ambala.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.
5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act, pending before ADJ, Panipat is transferred to District Judge, Ambala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
