1. The petition for transfer of case is sought from the court at Jhajjar to the court at Gurgaon. The distance between the places is 40 kilometers. The apprehension expressed by the petitioner is that the father-in-law of the respondent is an Advocate and an influential person. The respondent says that the father has suffered an paralytic attack and he is not in any influential position in the manner claimed by the petitioner. The petitioner is troubled by a barrage of 7 cases as having been instituted against her. I provide to her the transport expenses of ₹500/- at every date of hearing when she attends the court. The petitioner will be at liberty to apply for maintenance and the court will consider the case without reference

to the transport expenses which is awarded by this court. The petitioner will also be at liberty to apply for modification of the order for higher amount if such a justification is made and the court will consider the same and order the same appropriately.

2. The transfer application is dismissed but with the above directions.
