RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.(Oral)

No one has caused appearance on behalf of the respondent though he put in appearance in person on November 11, 2014. Respondent has not appeared today nor has caused appearance through counsel. Respondent is proceeded ex parte.

Ms. Shikha Jaidka, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that when the divorce petition was filed, the applicant was in the family way and today she has a two month old baby and it is very difficult for her to travel from Ludhiana to Patiala to defend the divorce petition.

In the considered view of this Court, this is sufficient reason to transfer the case from Patiala to Ludhiana and it is so ordered.
