Prayer in the CM is for placing on record copy of order dated 1.9.2014 passed in an appeal filed by the petitioner under Section 29 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005. No objection.

Allowed, as prayed for.

Main case

Reply has not been filed despite two opportunities. Again request has been made seeking time for filing reply. Declined.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Panipat to Jind.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as also an appeal under Section 29 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Jind. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 95 kilometers from Jind to Panipat on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the Parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Panipat is transferred to Jind. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
