As per the report of Registry, notice issued to respondent has been received back served but there is no representation on behalf of the respondent. Therefore, he is proceeded against exparte.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short “the Act”) filed by the respondent-husband from Jind to Karnal as the petitioner is presently residing at village Gogripur, Tehsil and District Karnal.

It is urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Karnal. It is further urged that she has also

filed a complaint under Section 406, 420, 498-A, 323, 506 and 120-B of IPC at Karnal. It is further urged that it is very difficult for the petitioner to travel 100 Kms. for attending each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before District Judge, Jind is transferred to District Judge, Karnal, who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
