Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Mediation has failed. Arguments have been advanced.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Mohali to Amritsar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC as also proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Amritsar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to undertake journey of 200 kilometers from Mohali to Amritsar on each and every date of hearing.

Counsel for the respondent has vehemently contested the prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Mohali is transferred to District Judge, Amritsar who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 12.6.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
