Reply on behalf of the respondent has not been filed even today though counsel for the respondent had sought adjournment on the previous date of hearing i.e. 28.04.2015 for this purpose. Request for adjournment for filing reply, thus, is declined.

In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Gurgaon to Bhiwani as the petitioner is residing with her parents at H.No.118-C, D.C. Colony, Bhiwani, Tehsil and District Bhiwani which is approximately 125 Kms. away from Gurgaon.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition

under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication in the court at Bhiwani. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Bhiwani and has also got registered a case bearing FIR No.69 dated 05.02.2014, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station, Bhiwani City against the husband-respondent and his family members.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before District Judge (Family Court), Gurgaon is transferred to Family Court, Bhiwani. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
