There is no representation on behalf of the respondent despite service. Therefore, he is proceeded against exparte.

In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Sonapat to Rohtak as the petitioner is residing with her parents and two minor children at Ward No.10, Landi Gali, Sampla, District Rohtak, Haryana, which is approximately 50 Kms away from Sopnepat.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Rohtak. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act,

2005 at Rohtak and has also got registered a case bearing FIR No.317/2012, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station, Sampla, Rohtak against the husband-respondent.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before District Judge (Family Court), Sonapat is transferred to District Judge, Rohtak who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
