Both the parties have stated that before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, a compromise has been effected between them. In terms of the compromise, ₹1,50,000/-(rupees one lac fifty thousand only) in cash are paid by the husband to the wife in the court today. The remaining amount i.e. ₹2,50,000/- (rupees two lac fifty thousand only) is to be paid before the lower court at the time of the disposal of the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, in terms of the compromise.

In terms of the compromise, the applicant wishes to withdraw the present application.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
