Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition for dissolution of marriage by way of a decree of divorce filed under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, which is pending adjudication at Pathankot.

As per report of the Registry, notices issued to respondents have been received back duly served but none has come present to represent them.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the wife (petitioner herein) has a four years old school-going child and it is very difficult for her to attend the proceedings at Pathankot while taking the child.

In view of the circumstances explained above, petition under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is ordered to be transferred from Pathankot to Jalandhar.

Compliance be made by the District & Sessions Judge, Pathankot.

The petition stands disposed of.
