Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Faridkot to Moga as the petitioner is residing with her parents at village Singhanwala, District Moga.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Moga.

3. Perusal of the paper book reveals that there was no representation on behalf of the respondent despite service on the last date of hearing i.e. 16.1.2015. Similar is the position even today. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Faridkot is transferred to District Judge, Moga, who may further transfer the same to the court of competent jurisdiction under him. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
