Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Ropar to Hoshiarpur.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing criminal proceedings inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 100 kilometers from Hoshiarpur to Ropar on each and every date of hearing more particularly, when the financial position of the petitioner's father is very weak and there is none in her family to accompany her.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Ropar is transferred to Hoshiarpur. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
