No one has come present on behalf of the respondent despite service. He is proceeded against *ex parte*.

Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, at Ferozepur as the petitioner-wife is residing at her parental home at Tarn Taran. It is claimed that distance between two cities is approximately 100 Kms and it is very difficult for the petitioner-wife to manage and pursue the proceedings competently and effectively in the petition filed under Section 9 of the Act at Ferozepur by travelling from Tarn Taran to attend the dates of hearing in the said petition.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. which is pending adjudication at Tarn Taran.

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In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner, as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Civil Judge [Senior Division], Ferozepur is transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Tarn Taran. Both the concerned Courts to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
