The petitioner-wife has filed the present petition under Section 24 of the Civil Procedure Code for transferring the petition filed by the respondent-husband titled as "Harpreet Singh vs Loveleen Kaur" under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the court of Sh. Jaspinder Singh, Addl. District Judge, Ludhiana to any court of competent jurisdiction at Kapurthala.

It is stated that the respondent-husband has filed the aforesaid petition at Ludhiana court and the petitioner-wife has filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Kapurthala court. The respondent-husband has re-married during the life time of the wife.

It is also stated that the parents of the present petitioner-wife are senior citizens and that she is unable to travel from Kapurthala to Ludhiana.

Earlier, on behalf of the respondent-husband, counsel had put in appearance and sought time to file reply but thereafter counsel became absent and has not filed any reply.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstance, the petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending in the court of Sh.Jaspinder Singh, Addl. District Judge, Ludhiana is withdrawn from his court and transferred to the court of learned District Judge, Kapurthala, who may retain the file himself or entrust the same to some other court of competent jurisdiction.

The present petition is allowed accordingly.
