Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Rohtak to Hisar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as also a criminal complaint inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 105 kilometers from Hisar to Rohtak on each and every date of hearing along with her minor child.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before District Judge, Rohtak is transferred to District

Judge, (Family Court), Hisar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 23.4.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
