As per office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back duly served but there is no representation on his behalf. He is, consequently, proceeded against ex-parte.

2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Sonapat to Ambala as the petitioner is residing alongwith her parents and minor son born on 24.7.2007 at Ambala, which is approximately 125 Kms. away from Sonapat.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a petition, interalia, under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication in the court at Ambala.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before District Judge (Family Court), Sonapat is transferred to District Judge (Family Court), Ambala. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
