Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short “the Act”) filed by the respondent-husband for grant of a decree of divorce from Karnal to Gurgaon.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 13 (i)(a) of Hindu Marriage Act, at Gurgaon. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 200 kilometers from Gurgaon to Karnal.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District & Sessions Judge, Karnal to Family Court at Gurgaon. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
