1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?

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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of divorce petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act titled as Karambir Singh Versus Monika, pending in the Family Court, Hisar, to court of competent jurisdiction at Jind.

It is stated that the petitioner had filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, in the Court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner has got two years old daughter. Hisar is 100 kilometers

away from Jind and she cannot go to Hisar to attend the proceedings.

It comes out that respondent is residing at village Barwala, which falls between Jind and Hisar and is 50 kilometers from Jind. It being so, Jind is not an inconvenient station for the respondent as well.

In these circumstances, the divorce petition titled as Karambir Singh Versus Monika, is withdrawn from the Family Court, Hisar and the same is transferred to the Court of learned District Judge, Jind, who may retain it with himself or transfer the same to some other competent Court.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
