As per report of the Registry, notice issued to respondent has been received back served but there is no representation on behalf of the respondent. Therefore, he is proceeded against exparte.

2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Gurdaspur to Jalandhar as the petitioner is residing with her old aged parents at Jalandhar which is approximately 120 Kms. away from Gurdaspur.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Jalandhar.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Gurdaspur is transferred to District Judge, Jalandhar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
