Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Panipat to Yamuna Nagar as the petitioner is residing with her parents at village Mugalwali, District Yamuna Nagar, which is more than 125 Kms. away from Panipat.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 13 of the Act against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Yamuna Nagar.

3. Perusal of the paper book reveals that there was no representation on behalf of the respondent despite service through sister-in-law (brother's wife) on the previous date of hearing i.e. 26.9.2014. Similar is the position even today. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.
5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before District Judge, Panipat is transferred to District Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
