**Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J.** (Oral):

Counsel for the respondent requests for an adjournment for filing reply. Since adjournment was already given for this purpose, no further adjournment is called for. Request is declined.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Panipat to Jind.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 as also proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Jind. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to undertake journey of 80 kilometers from Jind to Panipat on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Panipat is transferred to District Judge, Jind who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 12.6.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
