Despite service of the respondent, there is no representation on his behalf right from 31.3.2015. Even today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent. He is, consequently, proceeded against ex-parte.

2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Amritsar to Gurdaspur as the petitioner is residing alongwith her parents at Gurdaspur.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a petition, interalia, under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication in the court at Gurdaspur.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Amritsar is transferred to District Judge, Gurdaspur who may further assign the same to some other court of competent jurisdiction there. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
