Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Sri Muktsar Sahib to Mansa.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as also criminal proceedings in an FIR inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC and under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Budhladha. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 160 kilometers from Budhladha to Sri Muktsar Sahib on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner

as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Sri Muktsar Sahib is transferred to District Judge, Mansa who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 12.5.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
