There is an application under Section 151 C.P.C. for placing on record the reply of the transfer application filed by the petitioner.

In view of the facts mentioned in the application, the same is allowed.

Reply is taken on record.

TA No.686 of 2014

In this petition, petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Kurukshetra to Jind as the petitioner is residing with her father and her minor son at Ashri Gate near Vinod Ashri M.C. House, Bajan Mohalla, Jind, District Jind which is approximately 100

Kms away from Kurukshetra.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication in the court at Jind. Besides this, she has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Jind.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before District Judge, Kurukshetra is transferred to District Judge, Jind who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
