SABINA, J

Applicant has filed this application seeking transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 ('Act' for short) filed by the respondent titled as "Parminder Singh vs. Daljeet Kaur" from the Court of District Judge, Ropar to any Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the applicant has submitted that two cases were already pending between the parties at Jalandhar. Since the applicant was unemployed, it was difficult for her to travel to Ropar on each date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on the other hand has opposed the application.

Respondent has filed petition under Section 13 of the Act seeking dissolution of the marriage of the parties by way of a decree of divorce. Admittedly, proceedings under Section 125 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and a criminal case under Sections 406, 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 are pending

between the parties in the Court at Jalandhar. Since two cases are already pending between the parties at Jalandhar, it would be just and expedient to transfer the divorce petition from Ropar to Jalandhar.

Accordingly, this application is allowed. The divorce petition bearing HMA-7409 of 2013 titled as “Parminder Singh vs. Daljeet Kaur” is withdrawn from the Court of District Judge, Ropar and is transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.
