Reply filed on behalf of the respondent is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Roopnagar to Amritsar. It is averred that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Amritsar but this petition under Section 13 of the Act has been preferred by him at Roopnagar merely to harass, humiliate and dwarf her in her stature. It is further averred that the petitioner, besides attending to her duties as a medical officer, has also to take care of her studying minor female child and in these circumstances, it is very difficult to travel a distance of 220 kilometers from Roopnagar to Amritsar on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the circumstances explained in the petition, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 is ordered to be transferred from Roopnagar to the court of competent jurisdiction at Amritsar. Compliance be made by all concerned.

The petition stands disposed of.
