Opportunity to file reply is declined.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Jalandhar to Kapurthala.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings in a petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Sultanpur Lodhi, Kapurthala. Besides this, it would be very difficult for her to take up four hours one-way travelling from a remote rural area in Kapurthala to Jalandhar on each and every date of hearing, when her four years daughter will also be gravely inconvenienced.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending before District Judge, Jalandhar is transferred to District Judge, Kapurthala who may entrust it to any other competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 22.4.2015.

The petition stands disposed of.
