As per the report of Registry, notice issued to the respondent, Dasti as also ordinary, received back duly served but none has put in appearance on his behalf. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13(1)(ia) & (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Rewari to Bhiwani as the petitioner is 70% disabled residing with her parents at Bhiwani.

It is also urged that the petitioner had got registered a case interalia under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station, Bhiwani on 17.4.2011 against the respondent-husband, which is still pending at Bhiwani. Besides this, the petitioner-wife had also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, which was allowed by the District Judge (Family Court), Bhiwani on 14.8.2012. It is further urged that the petitioner

has also filed a petition under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from the Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Bhiwani against the husband-respondent.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13(1)(ia) & (ib) of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Rewari is transferred to District Judge, Bhiwani. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
