Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Ludhiana to Patiala.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Patiala as also proceedings in civil suit for damages instituted by the petitioner at Patiala. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 100 kilometers from Patiala to Ludhiana on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage

Act, 1955 pending at Ludhiana is transferred to District Judge, Patiala who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
