Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner claims that two other cases between the parties are already pending at Sangrur, which are being contested by the husband and this petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has been filed by the respondent-husband merely to harass and humiliate her. Details of the two cases pending between the parties have been given in the petition.

There is no objection from the side of the respondent-husband to the transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from Barnala to the court of competent jurisdiction at Sangrur.

In view of the circumstances explained in the petition and particularly when two other cases are already pending at Sangrur where the husband is contesting the same and as also the fact that the respondent-husband has no objection to the transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, the same is ordered to be transferred from Barnala to the court of competent jurisdiction at Sangrur. Compliance be made by the District & Sessions Judge, Barnala.

The petition stands disposed of.
