Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) for restitution of conjugal rights filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Kurukshetra to Jind as the petitioner-wife is residing at Jind which is approximately 125 Kms away from Kurukshetra.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed three cases i.e. petition under Section 125 Cr.PC, complaint under Section 498-A IPC and petition under Section 13 of the Act against the respondent-husband, which are pending adjudication at Jind.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before

Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kurukshetra is transferred to District Judge, Jind. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
