Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short “the Act”) filed by the respondent-husband from Nakodar to Moga.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C., which is pending adjudication at Moga. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 80 kilometers alongwith two minor children of 5 years and 2 ½ hears old from Nakodar, District Jalandhar to Moga on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional Civil Judge (Junior Division), Nakodar is transferred to District Judge, Moga who may assign it to any other court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of
