There is no representation on behalf of the respondent despite three pass overs on calls made. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Gurgaon to Rewari as the petitioner is residing alongwith her parents and a minor daughter born on 6.10.2011 at village Pithrawas, District Rewari, which is about 70 Kms. away from Gurgaon.

3. It is urged that the petitioner-wife has got registered a case interalia under Section 498-A IPC against the respondent-husband and his family members at Rewari. Besides this, she has also instituted two petitions against him i.e. one under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and another under Section 125 Cr.PC at Rewari.

4. In view of the submissions made by the counsel for the parties as also the circumstances mentioned in the petition, the request is allowed.
5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge (Family Court), Gurgaon is transferred to District Judge, Rewari, who may further assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction there. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
