Counsel for the petitioner-wife seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (hereinafter mentioned as the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, at Gurdaspur for restoration of conjugal rights against the wife, petitioner herein, and has urged that the aforesaid petition has been filed by the husband merely to harass and humiliate her. It is urged that the husband is already facing two more cases i.e. a petition under the Protection of Women From Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and the other petition under Section 125 Cr.PC in the courts at Ludhiana and has been attending the proceedings therein but has filed the petition under Section 9 of the Act at Gurdaspur.

No notice to the opposite side is being issued to avoid delay and further because no prejudice would be caused to the other party.

In view of the circumstances explained in the petition as also the fact that the husband is already attending two other cases at Ludhiana and there should not be any difficulty for him to attend this case as well at Ludhiana, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before the District Judge, Family Court, Gurdaspur is transferred to the District Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana. Compliance be made.

Disposed of accordingly.
