Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 25 of Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Malerkotla, District Sangrur to Panchkula as the petitioner is residing alongwith her parents and a minor son born on 9.10.2007 at Pinjore, Tehsil Kalka, District Panchkula.

2. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has filed a complaint, interalia, under Section 498-A IPC against the respondent-husband and his family members at Kalka, District Panchkula. Besides this, she has also instituted a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent-husband, which is also pending adjudication in the court at Kalka, District Panchkula.

3. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

4. Sequelly, the petition under Section 25 of the Act pending

before Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Malerkotla, District Sangrur is transferred to District Judge, Panchkula, who may further assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction there. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

5. Disposed of accordingly.
